To our contact lens patients: The following is a summary of the professional fees we charge in relation to your contact lens wear.

Contact Lens Evaluation: \$72 for all types of contact lenses

This is the minimum fee charged in addition to your yearly exam fee to renew a contact lens prescription from year to year; this fee covers additional tests the doctor performs with relation to your contact lenses. These tests may include examination of the cornea, assessment of the prescription, and fit of your contacts as well as discussions relating to the wear and care of your contact lenses.

Contact Lens Refitting Fee: \$72 for Soft Spherical Lenses

\$88 for Multifocal, Toric (astigmatic), & Spherical RGP Lenses

\$120 for Multifocal Toric Soft & RGP Lenses

This fee is charged in addition to the yearly exam fee and is for patients who currently wear contact lenses but need or want to change to another type of lens based on fit, comfort, and/or visual needs. This fee covers the testing the doctor performs during the exam plus any necessary additional visits for up to 90 days.

New Contact Lens Fitting: \$145 for Soft Spherical Lenses

\$165 for Multifocal, Toric, and Spherical RGP Lenses

\$185 for Multifocal Soft Toric and Multifocal and/or Bitoric RGP Lenses

This fee is charged in addition to the yearly exam fee and is for patients who have not previously worn contact lenses. This fee includes the doctor's examination for contacts, up to two one hour training classes to teach proper insertion and removal of contact lenses and follow up visits with the doctor up to 90 days after the initial exam.

Please note: Generally, contact lens evaluation and management/fitting fees are not covered by insurance companies, though some plans may allow you to utilize a portion of your dollar amount towards the evaluation/fitting fees or have a set copay for contact lens services. Our doctor and staff would be happy to answer any questions you may have.

I acknowledge that I have read and understand Eye Q Optometry's policies regarding contact lenses, and the fees associated. I understand that I have a 90-day period to return for follow-up appointments while wearing my contact lenses and to have my contact lens prescription finalized. Any contact lens refit requests/follow ups after 90 days from the initial contact lens exam date are subject to additional fees.
